## Globalisation and workers' livelihood security linkages: the case of the rmg sector of bangladesh\*

## Abstract

This paper has explored the globalisation and the labour dynamics issue focusing on the RMG sector of Bangladesh. In spite of having many discontents, globalisation has contributed positively to the Bangladesh's RMG sector. But in a competitive and changing global context, Bangladesh's RMG trade, with limited capability and linkages, is still under threat. In absence of protective measures in the globalisation process, shocks are diverted towards the workers that affect their livelihood. State intervention is required at national and global level for increasing RMG export in the globalised market and for ensuring livelihood security of the RMG workers.
